Accessing Your Product

You should already have your login information provided to you by your sales representative. Once logged in as a Returning User, you will see your CoursePoint+ product under the My Content tab.

How Your Students Access the Product

Your students will need two codes to access and enroll in your class for CoursePoint+. One to access the product (this is usually purchased) and another, the class code, to enroll in your class. You will need to provide the class code for your students. Once your students have their class code, they will enter it by clicking on the green **My Classes** Button at the right-hand side of the Course Content screen.

To create a class for your student enrollment, click on the **My Classes** button. You will then need to fill in the required fields. Once saved, you will need to provide the class code to your students so they can enroll. In the event that you need to locate the class code information again, click on **My Classes** button and then **View** for that particular class. You will then see the **+ How to add students** option at the top left. This option will provide you with your class code information. It is recommended to copy and paste this information and provide it to your students.

Course Content

The Course Content tab provides valuable resources for lesson planning and teaching.

- The Knowledge Acquisition lists under Course Content provides resources to strengthen your student's understanding of core content.
- The Concepts in Action Animations videos are animations with concepts that students in general most often struggle with.
- The Skills Mastery provides resources for you to develop professional competence that allow skills needed for the job. One notable resource is the Watch and Learn videos. These videos focus on real-life people performing nursing skills.
- The Lesson Planning column within the Course Content Instructor Resources provide great tools to enrich your teaching experience. To highlight a few:
 - Content Updates: The content updates provide a list of the updates within the CoursePoint+ eBook for that title. Content updates occur yearly.
 - Syllabi for both 14 and 28 week options

- Lesson Plans for each chapter
- QSEN Competency Map
- Power Points, an Image Bank, and more!
- The Teaching Resources section includes:
 - A downloadable Test Generator to make standard, paper tests for that title.
 - Answers to Pre-Lecture Quizzes, Case Studies, Assignments, and Discussion Topics.

The Reference Banner



At the top of the Course Content tab, you will see the Reference Banner. Each icon within this banner will take you to another part of the integrated content within CoursePoint+.

Videos

There are 19 total modules with several videos contained in each module. Students are to view all the videos in a module before taking a quiz on the material. Instructors can view best scores on the module quizzes for students on an individual and class basis. To view results, click into Classes and then view details. Module quizzes can be taken by students as many times as they like.

vSim for Nursing

As the instructor, you will be able to see all your students' attempts at a scenario and also their Post-Quiz scores.

The vSim Experience within the vSim Scenarios:



1. **Suggested Reading:** This tab provides suggested readings with SmartSense links to the eBook, Lippincott Procedures, and Lippincott Advisor. The SmartSense links  are hyperlinks that will take you directly to the information being presented for that reading, drug, diagnosis, or procedure.
2. **Pre-Simulation Quiz:** This section is a practice quiz for your students to prepare for the upcoming scenario. This is a low stakes quiz that offers instant remediation.
3. **vSim:** The link will take you into the scenario. Most simulations last 30 minutes. Some can be as long as 75 minutes. The simulations can be paused at any time so it does not time out. You can repeat the simulations as often as you want with the best score saved for the students to view, and all scores saved for instructors to see.
4. **Post-Simulation Quiz:** After finishing a scenario, your students may complete the Post-Simulation Quiz. This quiz does provide a score, and will test your students on their knowledge about what they did within the scenario.
5. **Documentation Assignment:** Provide practice documenting patient information and nursing care related to each simulation scenario. If you are using the electronic documentation platform, DocuCare, here you will find a hyperlink to that platform.
6. **Guided Reflection Questions:** These questions are intended to reinforce learning and promote improvement in performance.
